

Prof. Horia-Nicolai Teodorescu teaches at the Gheorghe Asachi Technical University of Iași, Dept. Electronics, Communications, and Information Technology, and at Al.I. Cuza University of Iași, Dept. of Computer Science. He is the Director of the Institute of Computer Science of the Romanian Academy (in Iași). Prof. Teodorescu has been a visiting or invited professor at universities in USA, Japan, Switzerland, and Spain. He is a member of the Romanian Academy and *dr. honoris causa* of the University of Pitești. He authored and co-authored several hundred papers, authored or co-edited more than 30 books and is an inventor or co-inventor of 24 patented inventions in USA, Japan, Romania, and several other countries. He enjoys interdisciplinary studies; the topics of his papers are classified by analytics in the main (sometimes superposing) domains as engineering 53%, computer science 52%, automation & control systems 13%, mathematics 7.4%, medical informatics 5.5%, operations research & management science 5.5%.
