INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

The length of a paper should be either 4 or 6 pages*. Please follow carefully the *Instructions for Authors and use the IEEE-Template-styles*. Each contributor (author or co-author) can submit **maximum three papers**.

*** extra payment will be 10 €/two extra pages, but no more than 12 pages/paper.**

Special/Invited SESSIONS (proposed by contributors)

Special/Invited sessions will include 4-5 invited papers. These papers should present a cohesive and comprehensive discussion of a relevant topic, consistent with the conference topics. The chairs could nominate an invited paper (30 minutes will be allocated for this presentation in the session). **Prospective organizers** are invited to submit by email the proposed session title and the extended (two pages) abstracts or the full papers. Deadlines for submission are mentioned below.

POSTERS and EXHIBITION

REGULAR PAPERS

These are requested in all areas consistent with the conference topics. Authors are asked to submit their original work by uploading it on the conference website the full papers of 4 or 6 *pages** length in electronic form.

Authors are requested to clearly point out - at paper submission and e-mail correspondence, *the name of the topic* to which their paper is submitted to (e.g., Environmental issues).

PAPERS PUBLISHING

The papers should be written in the IEEE-Template-styles format for publication on the ECAI Proceedings (ISSN 1843 – 2115). The ECAI Proceedings will be submitted to the IEEE Xplore® database and also to be evaluated and included in the ISI Web of Knowledge database.

Extended version of selected papers presented to the ECAI'20 will be free published in IEEE journals, but also in other journals (open-access with 20-50% discount) of our publishing partners (all indexed in ISI WoS), after that papers will be further reviewed as normal.
